

RULE IMPACT STATEMENT
HEARING PROCEDURES, PRACTICES, AND APPEALS 630:4 [REVOKED]

1. **DESCRIPTION:** Effective July 1, 2016, the Scenic Rivers Commission created pursuant to Section 1461 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes was terminated. On the same date, the rights and authorities of the Scenic Rivers Commission were transferred to the Grand River Dam Authority. Some of the above rules have been revised and are being proposed for promulgation as new Chapter 40 Scenic Rivers Rules and Chapter 45 Administration of Rules and Hearings under Title 300 Grand River Dam Authority.
2. **CLASSES OF PERSONS AFFECTED:** Affected persons are members of the public, business entities, the Board of Directors, Chief Executive Officer, and other officers and employees of Grand River Dam Authority.
3. **CLASSES OF PERSONS BENEFITTED:** Members of the public and business entities, as well as the Board of Directors, Chief Executive Officer, and other officers and employees of Grand River Dam Authority benefit from the rules.
4. **ECONOMIC IMPACT:** There is no economic impact relating to the proposed rule changes.
5. **COST:** There is no associated cost with this rulemaking action.
6. **IMPACT ON POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS:** No burden will be placed on any political subdivision.
