RULE IMPACT STATEMENT CHAPTER 1. OPERATIONS AND PROCEDURES [AMENDED]

- 1. **DESCRIPTION:** Grand River Dam Authority's principal administrative office relocated from Vinita, Oklahoma to Chouteau, Oklahoma and the address has been updated in the rules. The general description of the Authority has been expanded to include the additional responsibility of preservation of designated scenic rivers pursuant to 82 O.S. § 896.5. The defined term of "General Manager" has been replaced with the current title of "Chief Executive Officer" and has been updated throughout the chapter.
- 2. <u>CLASSES OF PERSONS AFFECTED</u>: Affected persons are members of the public, business entities, the Board of Directors, Chief Executive Officer, and other officers and employees of Grand River Dam Authority.
- 3. <u>CLASSES OF PERSONS BENEFITTED</u>: The rules inform members of the public, business entities, and the Board of Directors, Chief Executive Officer, other officers and employees regarding the purposes of Grand River Dam Authority and its business structure.
- 4. **ECONOMIC IMPACT:** There is no anticipated economic impact relating to the proposed rule changes.
- 5. <u>COST</u>: There is no associated cost with this rulemaking action.
- 6. <u>IMPACT ON POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS</u>: No burden will be placed on any political subdivision.
- 7. <u>ADVERSE EFFECT ON SMALL BUSINESS</u>: The proposed changes do not result in adverse effects for small business.
