RULE IMPACT STATEMENT LAKE RULES 300:35 [AMENDED]

- 1. **DESCRIPTION:** A clarification is proposed that permit fees will not be prorated. The sanctioned event definition has been modified to include off-road events. Language has been added to allow for usage of GRDA public ramps to launch new or refurbished docks if the action does not interfere with the public's access to the water and prohibits the building of docks on GRDA's public ramps. Applications for a dock installer's permit may be denied.
- 2. <u>CLASSES OF PERSONS AFFECTED</u>: Affected persons are members of the public, business entities, the Board of Directors, Chief Executive Officer, and other officers and employees of Grand River Dam Authority.
- 3. <u>CLASSES OF PERSONS BENEFITTED</u>: Members of the public and business entities benefit from the protections and regulations contained in the rules. The Board of Directors, Chief Executive Officer, other officers and employees of Grand River Dam Authority benefit by the direction and consistency the rules provide.
- 4. **ECONOMIC IMPACT:** There is no anticipated economic impact relating to the proposed rule changes.
- 5. **<u>COST</u>**: There is no associated cost with this rulemaking action.
- 6. **IMPACT ON POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS:** No burden will be placed on any political subdivision.
- 7. <u>ADVERSE EFFECT ON SMALL BUSINESS</u>: The proposed changes do not result in adverse effects for small business.
- 8. **LESS COSTLY METHODS:** No less costly methods were identified.
- 9. <u>SIGNIFICANT RISKS</u>: None.
- 10. **<u>DETRIMENTAL EFFECT</u>**: None.
